



## NURSING ASSISTANT

The Nursing Assistant program provides students with the knowledge and skills necessary to perform basic care services for a resident/client in a variety of health care settings, including but not limited to, hospitals, nursing homes, and assisted living facilities. The nursing assistant provides basic patient care under the supervision of a nurse. Upon successful completion of the program, students will receive a career certificate in Nursing Assistant. This program prepares the student to take and pass the state examination to become a Certified Nursing Assistant.

### EMPLOYMENT OUTLOOK

Demand for Nursing Assistants is expected to grow roughly 17% between 2016-2026.\*  
Entry level wages for Nursing Assistants are about \$12.07/hour\*\*
